

POST CAPS TIPS

Wood post caps provide many functions for a fence or deck post. They provide protection against rot and decay by keeping the moisture out of the top of the post. In addition, post caps provide an aesthetic value, beautifying the fence or deck post. They turn the ordinary into extraordinary. Post caps are sold in their "natural state" - that being raw wood - most commonly cedar, redwood, or treated pine. The post cap should be painted or stained before installation on the post. If possible, dip the post cap into the paint or stain, wiping the excess off with a cloth or brush. To install on post, place a ring of exterior rated construction adhesive around the top perimeter of the post. Press the cap in place and center on post.
